With reference to your letter dated 6th October, and my reply of 13th October, I enclose for your information a copy of a letter which has been received from the Society's Secretary at Glasgow, the contents of which are self explanatory.

In view of this letter, and the recommendations made by the Glasgow Surveyors, the Committee have continued the ship's class subject to the 45 fathoms of worn chain cable being renewed by the end of January, 1966, and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements you propose making in this respect. On the satisfactory replacement of this equipment, a fresh notation of Special Survey 5.65 will then be assigned.
