With reference to previous correspondence about this case and in particular to the question of verification of the size of 90 fathoms of chain cable, we have to inform you that the above vessel has returned to Hull and is expected to leave in about 10 days time.

The Owners have now requested that a further examination of the chain cable be deferred until the next drydocking which should normally be in April, May 1966, would you please let us have your remarks regarding this proposal.

Safety valve springs are still not available and it may be necessary to defer this item as well for a short period.

The remaining items will be dealt with here before the vessel leaves.
