With reference to our telephone call to you and to your subsequent letter dated 8th instant the above vessel has been at Hull and Classification requirements have been discussed with the Master and Chief Engineer.

Before renewing the 90 fathoms of chain cable stated by the Surveyors in Piraeus to be undersize the Owners have requested that a further examination be held and the sizes of these six lengths checked.

Safety valve springs have been ordered but will not be available for about six weeks.

In the circumstances, as the vessel was urgently required and her stay at this port of short duration they have requested that all outstanding requirements be deferred until her return to this port from her present voyage to Russia, which should be in about five weeks time.

The vessel has now sailed but would you please confirm that this proposed arrangement is in order, and also confirm that the fitting of protection for the boiler water level gauge glasses is a condition of class.
