In compliance with your telephone request of Friday, I would inform you that to complete the Special Survey of the hull for the notation SS 5.65, 90 fathoms of chain cable (Nos. 4 and 5 starboard side and Nos. 4 to 7 port side) require to be renewed.

With regard to the machinery, the vessel will be eligible for the notation ES 5.65 when the diesel auxiliary generator engine has been examined.

The class is subject to the steam smothering system being installed in way of oil fuel pumps port and starboard side and portable fire extinguishers or equivalent in machinery space being made in accordance with the Rules by the end of July and to all boiler safety valve springs being renewed and water level gauge glasses being suitably protected upon arrival at a British Port by the end of the present month.

The vessel will be eligible for the record MBS 5.65 when the above condition has been dealt with.

The Steampipe Survey has recently been carried out at Piraeus.

It is concluded that the above matters will be dealt with at Hull and your report is awaited in due course.
