1041 "AUGUSTA PAULIN". As recommended.

It is concluded that shell plates H.15 and G.16 (port side) in way of No.5 hold are the same plates as those reported by the Casablanca Surveyors as E.4 and F.3 (port side) in way of No.5 hold, but your confirmation is desired.

1024 "NIDARHOLM". As recommended, postponement of the Special Survey until the end of December 1964 having been approved. I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.

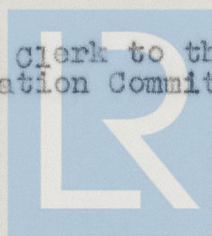
With regard to the machinery, I shall be glad if you will confirm that all requirements of Circular No.1959, have been dealt with.

1018/1023/1030 "TASSIA" ex "ANNETTE". As recommended, except that the machinery class has been continued subject to the superheaters of both boilers being renewed at the earliest opportunity, and to the evaporator not being used until surveyed.
