am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register
of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following*

survey records assigned MBS 4,64 and ES (with date) upon completion
and without condition of class regarding ballast pump water end
and regarding superheater elements but subject to evaporator
not being used until surveyed as previously recommended and to
main engine IP piston valve (Metalocked) being specially
examined by 10,64 (6 months).
