Dear Mr Linklater,

With reference to the plans of Rudder and Stern Frame for the above named vessel approved on the 15th February last, I have to call your attention to the correction made on the plan in respect to the diameter of the holes in the gudgeons.

It was believed that the figure 210  $\frac{3}{4}$  related to the thickness of the Rudder post and this was altered to 212  $\frac{3}{4}$ . The correction should be cancelled, as the thickness of the Rudder post is 223  $\frac{3}{4}$ .

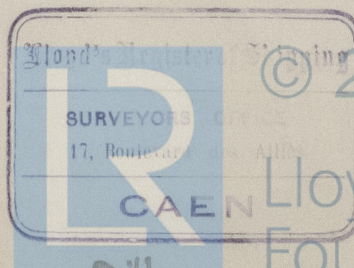
Please notify the Builders accordingly, and make the necessary correction on their copy of the plan as well as your own.
