"SAINT BONIFACE" Caen Damage Report.

With reference to the above Report on damage sustained by the s.s. "SAINT BONIFACE" now lying at Cherbourg, I have to forward herewith, for the information of the Committee, copy of a letter (translation) which has come to hand from the Chantiers Navals Français, this morning.

The question referred to in this correspondence has also been discussed with Mr. Puissesseau, who called on me this morning and informed me of his visit to the ship at Cherbourg.

In the circumstances, I have to comply with the Builders' request to examine the vessel and I am arranging to proceed to Cherbourg, in company with Mr. Linklater on Monday, the 4th instant, with a view to confirming his report or making any modifications which, on re-examination, we may mutually agree to. I shall report fully on the subject, as soon as possible.
