With reference to your letters of the 29th Dec. 22 and 1st January and our communications in reply, we have proceeded to carry out the accumulation of pressure test on the boiler of the above named vessel at Cherbourg and have found this to be satisfactory. It was observed that after the safety valves had lifted at the pressure to which they had been adjusted that the pressure remained constant for about 15 minutes and then diminished.

With regards to the dimensions of the safety valves this has been verified by the undersigned on the vessel and found to be 83<sup>m</sup>/m diameter and not as stated in our previous communication.

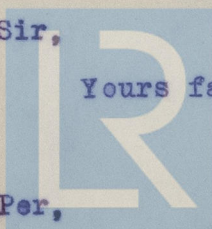
