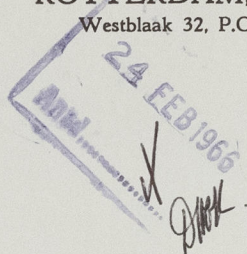

The combustion chamber stays of Port boiler have now been renewed and we regret that this was not made clear in our report.

We herewith confirm that the centre boiler mountings were examined at this time as mentioned on our interim certificate but unfortunately omitted in our report.

We apologize for not mentioning the remaining items for completion of the survey in the body of our report and the trouble this may have caused you.

The last paragraph of your letter has, with great concern, been carefully noted and care will be taken to avoid this in future cases.
