62327 "KORCULA". As recommended.

I shall be glad if you will state the conditions of the boilers now examined and on which boiler the combustion chamber stays were renewed. You should confirm that the centre boiler mountings were examined, as there is no indication of this in the report.

In future, you should state on the report as well on the Interim Certificate, the items remaining to be examined to complete the survey.

It will be appreciated if you will exercise more care in completing reports in future.

62281 "AGNES". As recommended.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that you have omitted to state on the Rpt. SB, whether or not an approved oil gland is fitted.

62320 "AMELAND". As recommended.

In connection with the hull qualification of class, your attention is drawn to Instructions to Surveyors, Part 3a, 1963, Amendment No.1, and I shall be glad if you will state why this item has not been dealt with and also whether this condition may now be amended to "being kept under observation".
