Postponement of Special Survey

Dear Sir,

I beg to refer to telephone conversations I had with Mr. Cook on the 10th July about a deferment until 31st December, 1962 and on the 16th July about a second proposal for deferment until the end of March, 1963.

I have now before me a letter from Messrs. Shell Tankers, Rotterdam, saying :

"We have now received confirmation from our London Associates that the above-mentioned vessel will remain in service until 31st December, 1962, whereafter she will be withdrawn from service.

m.s. "MITRA" will, as requested by Lloyd's London, be offered for a general examination afloat and a substantial advancement of the C.M.S. will be carried out concurrently.

The vessel has been stemmed at the N.D.S.M. Amsterdam on her return from Curacao on or about 6th September, 1962. We understand a boiler survey is not required."

As regards Messrs. Shell Tankers' remark that a Boiler Survey is not required, I shall be pleased if you will confirm that their assumption is correct.
