We have received the following letter from Messrs. Shell Tankers N.V. dated 3rd July, 1962:

"The above named vessel was due for Special Survey June 1962, but in view of the plans to withdraw the ship from service in July/August, 1962, the survey has not been commenced."

We have now been approached by our London Associates with a query whether there is a possibility to extend the trading of the ship until 31st December, 1962, without incurring docking/Special Survey costs, thereby assuming the ship to be sold at the end of the extension period.

"MITRA" is operating, in the white oil trade, between Curacao and Europe and is at present in the Curacao area.

"We should appreciate your comments on the possibility of granting us an extension as outline above. As this matter is of some urgency, we should be grateful for a reply at your earliest convenience."

We shall be pleased to receive your comments for transmission to Owners and Netherlands Authorities.
