on the 1st September, 1966 and subsequently, as she lay afloat at Karachi, for General Examination for further postponement of the Special Survey (due 8/65) and Wear & Tear Repairs

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am

recommending that she be continued as classed without fresh record of survey, subject to shell plate H.6 port side aft (doubled), to the tweendeck stringer plating (doubled) and temporarily repaired shell frames at tweendeck level all over, to the temporarily repaired shell frames in No.2 hold P & S, to the watertight bulkheads between Nos.1 & 2 and Nos.3 & 4 holds (bottom strakes doubled) all being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary at the next Special Survey, also subject to all other outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.
