Motorship "PHOENICIAN STAR".

I am obliged to you for forwarding here copies of your letters addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Hong Kong on 23rd June and 8th instant, concerning the above named ship.

The Committee have had your request under consideration today and while they fully appreciate your natural desire to complete the voyages at present planned, they much regret they cannot feel justified in continuing the ship in class beyond the end of next month when the year of grace for the Special Survey will expire.

As you must be aware, this ship is already 30 years old and at surveys held at Karachi in January, at Yokohama in March, and Hakodate in April 1966, shell plates were found to be wasted and holed.
