Re: m.s. Phoenician Star.

We are in receipt of a photostat copy of your letter dated 18th June, '66 through our Agents - Winley Shipping Company, Hongkong, in respect of captioned vessel which is on continuous survey.

In reply to your said letter we submit as under:-

We had decided to conduct and complete the balance of special survey in Japan to which Country the ship is scheduled to load for. As a matter of fact we were expecting to complete the voyage by August, '66 by which date we are supposed to complete the special survey in Japan. Unfortunately the ship is behind schedule for about two months and that means that she will be placed for completion of her survey by the end of October, '66.

For your information we may mention here that the said ship is now discharging her cargo in Bilbao (Spain) and shall complete by 28th of this month and wherefrom she will proceed to Bordeaux, France to load outward cargo and thence she shall be bound to Japan via Karachi/Marmagoa - after discharging and loading of outward cargo.

We strongly hope that your good selves shall accede to our request to complete the balance of special survey by October, '66 especially in the circumstances when the ship is scheduled to proceed a port where special survey is to be conducted.

The steampipe survey shall, of course, be conducted in conjunction with the special survey.
