Shell plate H7 (PSa) in way of No.5 hold found wasted and holed and now temporary repair effected by fitting welded doubler.

On completion necessary hose test carried out and found satisfactory.

It is recommended that this item be specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the special survey. Appropriate entry to be made in the S.R.L.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated. I recommend, therefore, that this ship remain as classed with/without fresh record of dry docking subject to shell plate H7 (PSa) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at special survey and also to any outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.
