It is understood that this vessel has been sold to Messrs. Mediterranean Maritime Company, of Lebanon, and it is concluded the new Owners will maintain classification with this Society, but I shall be glad to receive your confirmation on this point.

The Screwshaft Survey became due so long ago as August last but postponement of this inspection until the end of the present month was agreed to by the Committee last month. In the circumstances I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are proposed to be made for this inspection to be carried out.


At the same time I would inform you that the vessel's class has been continued subject, inter alia, to shell plates in H and J strakes in way of frames 68 (port side) and 71-73 (starboard side) and upper deck plating in way being permanently repaired at the next drydocking by the end of last month, and the position regarding this matter will also be appreciated.

An early reply is desired.

It will be noted that the Special Survey will become due at the end of August and information regarding this inspection will be appreciated in due course.
