her class will be withdrawn at the same time.

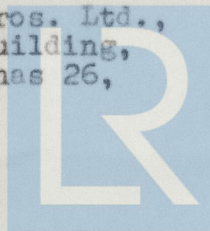
In the circumstances, I shall be glad if
