 PANAGHIA SYRIOTISSA. — London, Oct. 12. — The following has been received from the owners of steamer Panaghia Syriotissa in Piraeus: Following cable received from the master, dated Oct. 11: Steamer Panaghia Syriotissa fire at Novorossisk Anchorage while in bad weather trying to sail. Vessel tripped (? trapped) on rocks. — London, Oct. 12.
 — The owners of steamer Panaghia Syriotissa have received the following cable, dated Oct. 12: Panaghia Syriotissa: Master and Inflet, Novorossisk, contacted on telephone and explained that extensive damage due to fire, which started at 6 a.m., Oct. 10, while vessel was in Novorossisk Roads, awaiting loading berth. At 6.30 a.m., master called assistance of two Russian salvage vessels with whose assistance fire was put out. Master signed salvage contract "no cure no pay." Extensive damage in engine-room and accommodation amidships. Vessel towed into port and crew evacuated into hotels as impossible to accommodate on board. Local surveyor being appointed.
