Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 19th ultimo, respecting the fees to be charged for the survey of the Hull and Machinery of the Steamer "BLACKWORTH" (Greenock First Entry Report No. 17508 and Glasgow First Entry Reports Nos. 38670 & 38991) up to the time of transfer to private ownership, I have to enclose herewith a copy of a letter which I have to-day addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Greenock respecting this case, from which you will see that an account has to-day been rendered to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the fees in question.

Of the fee for the survey of the Machinery, one-quarter, viz:—£2. 10. 0, will be credited to your part for the survey of the Boilers during construction at the makers' works, and, on payment, your account will be credited accordingly. I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debt Books accordingly.
