With reference to the notice addressed to the Owners on the 13th April last regarding the Annual Load Line and Classification Surveys I shall be glad to learn whether any action has yet been taken in view of the fact that the period of grace allowed for completion of the Load Line Survey expired on the 20th proximo.

I think it well to point out that the Annual Survey carried out at Durban in February 1950 was in respect of the survey due in June 1949.

This vessel together with the S.S. "BONNEVELD" is now owned by S.A. NATIONALE REDERY (EDMS) BPK, and the Managers are Van Riebeeck Lines (PTY) Ltd., 220, Grand Parade Centre, Trafalgar Place, P.O. Box 1916, CAPE TOWN.

The new Managers have now stated that the vessel will be submitted for Drydocking and Annual Survey as soon as a drydock becomes available at this port, expected to be within the month. (present
