In July 1948, Mr. Boyle reported that the Owners were not prepared to submit the vessel to Special Survey and had obtained a Provisional Load Line Certificate from the B.C. On the 9th July, the Committee expunged the class with a red line.

Mr. Robinson, the B.C. Non-Exclusive Surveyor at Durban subsequently carried out a classification survey which was completed in January, 1949.

After fusion, it was decided that a confirmatory survey should be held by an Exclusive Surveyor to the Unified Society. This survey was held by Mr. van Lare who reported adversely on the vessel's condition, as a result of which the Classing Committee, on the 23rd September, declined to assign any classification or to authorise the issue of a Load Line Certificate until the Special Survey had been re-held by the Society's Surveyors and all repairs effected to their satisfaction.

By this time the Owners were in liquidation and the vessel up for sale.

Mr. Boyle now reports that a provisional American Bureau Class and Load Line Certificate have now been issued by the Local Surveyor, who was originally the B.C. Non-Exclusive Surveyor.
