I duly received your letter of the 23rd instant regarding the case of the steamer "BOKKEVELD" and note the reply which has now come to hand from Messrs. Hean, Robinson & Cruickshank.

Meanwhile we are in touch with Mr. Boyle, the Society's Senior Surveyor for South Africa, who is temporarily at Port Natal, in regard to the Confirmatory Survey.

In a letter dated 19th instant he states the Owners' affairs are in a very bad way and that a Liquidator has just been appointed by the Court, so it is quite likely there may be some delay in arranging the requisite inspection.

Meantime it would seem that the provisional load line certificate issued by Mr. Robinson expired in April last last, and I shall be glad to learn if you have heard anything further on this point.
