We have pleasure in informing you that the survey reports and documents relative to the classification of this ship have been submitted to the Committee, and the hull and machinery accepted for class 100 respectively, subject to confirmatory survey, and the supplying of lengths of chain cable as requested by the Durban surveyor in his report.

The confirmatory survey is in the nature of a general examination of hull and machinery without opening up unless the examination indicates that the original survey has not been complete, and should be carried out by an exclusive surveyor to the Society.

Hull and machinery classification certificates are being issued and these will be sent to you as soon as satisfactory reports are received on the confirmatory survey.
