Dear Sir:

With reference to your letter of 24th June regarding your letter of 23rd April inquiring about the Screwshaft Survey on this ship, I have to advise you that this Trawler suffered severe fire damage while at sea on 30th April with the loss of several lives, and was towed to Dartmouth, N. S.

The vessel was attended on 7th May as she lay on the Slipway at Dartmouth, N.S., in order that an examination of the underwater portion could be made and a specification of repairs drawn up.

The Owners appear anxious to claim a total constructive loss, and the Underwriters appear to be disputing this claim, so that no work of any kind has been carried out, and the vessel is at present lying afloat at Dartmouth in a dead condition.

The fire damage is confined to the accommodation spaces, engine room and machinery casing

In the event of a total loss being declared, I will inform you accordingly.
