Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in June, 1948.

All drain scuppers from tween decks (previously led to hold bilges) have now been closed by E.W. plates at main deck, and drain scuppers from Tween decks now led to Machinery space bilges (P. & S.) with self closing cock at their lower ends in accordance with requirements. ✓
Drain holes cut in tween deck bulkheads to permit drainage to scuppers. ✓
Drain scuppers from Tonnage well (P. & S.) controlled from shelter deck have now been fitted with means of indicating whether valve is open or closed. ✓
