S. I am in receipt of your letter of the 27th instant with reference to the new Motor Vessel "CONDE DE CHURRUCA", and in reply thereto I have to acquaint you that the fee for the survey of the engines installed in this vessel according to Section 29 of the Rules is £115. Of this the sum of £50 has been charged to the engine builders by the Society's Surveyor at Winterthur, and I shall be glad if you will be good enough to arrange to render an account for £65. to the Ship builders.

A fee for the survey of the Auxiliary Boiler according to the Rules is £7.15.0 and this should also be charged by you.
