Whaler "STORA" - "Surveys overdue 10.54"  
Whaler "SOUTHERN CHIEF" - "Surveys overdue 5.55"  
Whaler "SOUTHERN SPRAY" - "Surveys overdue 12.54"

The cases of these ships, which are recorded in the Register Book with the above mentioned notation, have been reviewed in this office.

In view of the fact that the Special Surveys became due so long ago as 10.54, 5.55 and 12.54 respectively, and it appears that no arrangements are envisaged for these and other overdue surveys to be put in hand, the Committee consider the time has arrived when the classes should be omitted from the next reprint of the Register Book and they have, therefore, given instructions for the following notations to be inserted in lieu thereof, namely:-

"STORA" - "Classed BC until 10.54"  
"SOUTHERN CHIEF" - "Classed BC until 5.55"  
"SOUTHERN SPRAY" - "Classed BC until 12.54"

They desire me to add, however, that should it be decided to recommission these vessels their classes will immediately be reinstated after a Special Survey has been satisfactorily held.
