The Second Special Survey No. 2 became due in June last year, and the Boiler Survey in October last.

The trawler was sold in September last, and proceeded to British Columbia, and despite repeated efforts both from this Office and the Society's office at Vancouver no reply has been received from the registered Owner in regard to any arrangements for the overdue surveys to be carried out.

The Vancouver Surveyor stated in March last that the registered Owner was an employee of a local concern engaged in rum-running off the Californian coast, and that he understood this vessel was also employed in that business, and in view of the fact that a registered letter to the Owner making inquiry with regard to the overdue surveys has been returned undelivered through the post, the Classing Committee, who had the case again before them on Friday, the 24th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (5.29), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Vancouver Surveyor has been informed accordingly.
