A satisfactory General Examination of this vessel was made by the Aberdeen Surveyors in September, and in the circumstances the Committee agreed to the Special Survey being postponed for a time.

The trawler was subsequently sold and proceeded to Canada. In reply to enquiry the Vancouver Surveyors stated in March that the vessel had not arrived at that port, that he had not been able to get into touch with the registered Owner, also that letters addressed to him had failed to elicit a reply. The Surveyor further intimated that the registered Owner was an employee of a local concern engaged in rum-running off the
