S. I have to inform you that the Committee have to-day had before them reports of a survey carried out by the Society's Surveyor at Hamburg (April 1948/July 1949) on this vessel.

The class of 100A1, With Freeboard, has been assigned, together with Special Survey notations of S.S. Ham - 7,49 and LMC 7,49, and I therefore have pleasure in enclosing Classification Certificates herewith.

It is noted that the bower anchors and nearly all of the chain cable has been tested by the Germanischer Lloyd, and while the testing of anchors and chain cables at Proving Establishments outside Great Britain complies with the Rules of this Society for classification purposes, I think it well to draw your attention to the requirements of the Anchors and Chain Cables Act in respect of British ships.
