I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for Repairs to rudder stock.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

Attended on board the vessel at the Master's request to inspect the rudder and rudder stock.

The Master stated the vessel to be en route to Australia from the U.K. and on leaving the U.K. difficulty was experienced with keeping the vessel on course. The vessel called in at the port of Lisbon where the effective rudder areas was increased under the supervision of a Surveyor to the Society.

NOW DONE The rudder stock examined and found to be cracked over a length of approximately 4" starting from the coupling flange radius and rising. The rudder and stock were removed and new stock forged. The bottom rudder pintle was built up with weld and machined to suit the skeg bush. Rudder steady bearing renewed.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed xxx without fresh record of dry docking and subject to any outstanding condition of Class being dealt with as previously recommended.

At the request of the Owner's Representative 3" was cropped off the trailing edge of the rudder to reduce the area. This reduction still leaves the area greater than that before the first modification.

On completion of the repair rudder trials were carried out with satisfactory results.
