Dear Sir,

I wish to draw your attention to Liverpool Report No. 165007 on the "MERSEY ENGINEER", against which there is a notation in the Register Book at the present time of "Laid up - Surveys overdue 9,62".

The vessel has just been sold to the Westminster Dredging Co., but the Mersey Docks and Harbour Board arranged for the Boiler Survey to be held before the sale was completed.

The new Owners have decided to keep the vessel in class and are accordingly carrying out the Special Survey at the present time. It is likely that some alterations will also be carried out to the ship, and the Westminster Dredging Co., hope to complete the work by the end of the year.

I informed the Liverpool Committee of the arrangement and they thought that it would be best to give the Owners until the end of January to complete the Special Survey and allow classification to be retained.
