ANSWER

With reference to your Memorandum of the 12th September, I shall be glad to learn whether any decision has yet been reached regarding this vessel's future.

Date:— 4th October, 1962.

I expect to have a firm date from the Dock Board in a day or two for a General Examination on this ship. They promised on the 13th September to arrange for a General Examination within a month. I have been holding up a reply pending some information about drydocking.

I shall be glad to have your confirmation that if the Dock Board do not find it convenient to dock the ship, as seems likely, the Committee will not press. You will see that the last docking was 9,61 and the point to remember is that it is unlikely that the Board will wish to keep the vessel in service beyond next summer.

I have not put the case before the Liverpool Committee because of the lack of a definite proposal.
