SENT FROM NEW YORK on January 10th, 1961:-

GENERAL LAZARO CARDENAS UNDERSTAND FROM PULFORD YOU DO NOT WISH TO PROCEED WITH RECLASSIFICATION SURVEY WHILE VESSEL ON DRYDOCK AT TAMPA NOW STOP CONCLUDE HOWEVER YOU WILL RECLASS AT SOME FUTURE DATE THEREFORE RECOMMEND SURVEYOR BE GIVEN OPPORTUNITY EXAMINE VESSEL ON DRY DOCK NOW AS THIS SURVEY ESSENTIAL FOR COMPLETION RECLASSIFICATION SURVEY STOP PLEASE CABLE REPLY TO ENABLE US INSTRUCT SURVEYOR.

211 REURTEL TENTH STOP KINDLY TELEGRAPH COST SURVEY LAZARO CARDENAS ON DRYDOCK STOP

SENT FROM NEW YORK on January 12th, 1961:-

GENERAL LAZARO CARDENAS REURTEL IF SURVEY FOR DRYDOCKING ONLY FEE AND EXPENSES ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS STOP IF FOR RECLASSIFICATION AND SURVEYOR CARRIES OUT FULL SURVEY INCLUDING EXAMINATION AND TESTING OF REPAIRS DONE NOW FEE AND EXPENSES FIFTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS.
