With reference to the correspondence which took place between us in July last regarding the above named vessel, I beg to acquaint you that the report of survey held at Baltimore in August/September has now come to hand and it is noted therefrom that a special Survey No.3 for classification has been completed so far as hull is concerned.

When the Machinery Survey has been completed, the vessel will be eligible for a class of 100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" with notations of S.S.No.3-12,44. DBS 12,44. and S 10,44. and in the meantime a record of 100A1 (Class Contemplated) "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" will be inserted in the Register Book.

I think it well to enclose, for your information, an extract from the Surveyor's report in regard to the parts remaining to be examined to complete the Machinery Survey.
