In reply to your classing letter of the 3rd instant on the above vessel, we have to say that the thickness of the horizontal girder on cargo tank bulkheads including owners thickness is .50" and that B.A. stiffeners are fitted to Peak and Cargo tank bulkheads. ✓

3½" x 3½" x .48" back bars are fitted to the shell lugs of the bottom transverses in centre cargo tanks. ✓

The lengths of Poop and Bridge are 99'3" and 47'0" respectively. ✓

The breadth and thickness of the upper deck stringers in way of bridge is 74" x .88". ✓

We regret the above omissions.
