Dear Sir,

The s.s. "HILARY" belonging to the Booth Steamship Company, is due to arrive in this Port at the end of August and will sail again on the 14th October. During this period the vessel will be dry docked and put through the remainder of the Annual Passenger Certificate Survey.

Looking at their programme, the Owners do not see how they can carry out the Special Survey in April 1960 when due, and would like to put this off until the end of September 1960.

If the Committee are agreeable, the Owners will hold a General Examination in dry dock while the vessel is in the Port, and will also draw the Screwshaft for Survey. They have recently carried out a Boiler Survey on the ship.

I have told them that their proposal will be accepted.
