Booth Steamship Co., Liverpool, for s.s. "HILARY", for despatch to Palmers, Jarrow.

The set comprises :-

- Two Steel Aux. Heaters, Steam Raising (Coil type). 400 lbs.
- One Steel Paraffin Container, 150 lbs. W.T.
- One Steel Thermometer Pot, 400 lbs. W.T.
- One Aux. Discharge Strainer, $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick, 400 lbs. W.T.

These fittings were water tested as above, marked with Surveyor's initials and test pressures, and found sound and workmanship good.
