Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in _____

The wood hatch covers at Nos. 2, 3, 4 & 5 hatchways on upper deck and No. 1 hatch on forecastle deck have been dispensed with and replaced by M.E.P. Steel Hatch covers. The L. & A. Trunk at fore end of No. 5 hatch on upper deck has been plated over at upper deck level and space at centre used as deck locker. The top of L. & A. Trunk at wings has been plated over and 1 vent coaming p. & s. fitted on top of trunk, coamings 13" x 8" x 15" high and of substantial construction. Vents fitted with fixed mushroom tops.
