In reply to your letter dated 25th instant regarding the approved plans of the "JULIETA" built at Amsterdam, the "MARTINA" & "MARSELLA" built at Rotterdam. I may state that all plans were dealt with in London through Mr. Curchin and we received the copies from the Builders, only a few plans were dealt with at this end and copies sent to London. We are still dealing with two sister vessels after the same plans one at Amsterdam and one at Rotterdam No. 178 "JUSTINA" and No. 95 "MANUELLA" and we will require these plans in completing the vessels.

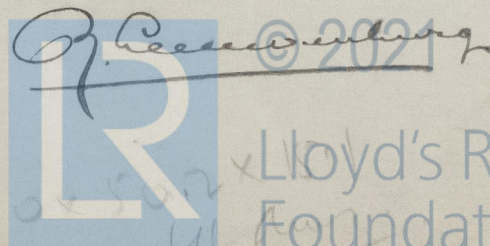
The s.s. "MARIQUITA" built at Rotterdam Yard No. 84 is a sister vessel of the s.s. "JUANITA" No. 174 built at Amsterdam and so far as I find all approved plans must be in London.

I will see which plans are left in Amsterdam so that I will forward them to you as desired.
