M. I am in receipt of Mr. Herwerden's freeboard report on the S.S. "MARTINA", Messrs. In compliance with your request I have wired you this afternoon as follows:-

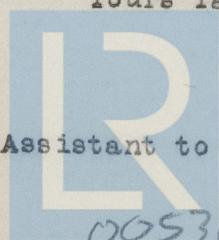
MARTINA = Vessel's name
ALHRY) = The freeboard assigned is 4'-2" from top of
ALJIR) statutory deck line to centre of disc.
ALLYX = The statutory deck line is 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " above the steel
deck at side.
ALPDO = The other lines should be marked as follow:-
Fresh Water 3" above centre of disc.
ALSIB = Winter 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " below centre of disc.
AMABY = Compulsory freeboard.
