ALTERATIONSNEW ACCOMMODATION FOR GUNNERS IN BRIDGE SPACE (Port side forward)

COMPANIONWAY - For access to gunners' quarters in bridge space, in sidehouse abreast saloon house (p.s), opening 5'0" x 2'2", sill 18", closed by a strong hinged wood door capable of being operated from both sides. ✓

SIDE SCUTTLES - Additional side scuttles fitted in shell in way of gunners' quarters, 10" dia. of strong construction and fitted with strong hinged deadlights. ✓

SANITARY DISCHARGES - Discharges from W.C.s, washbasins & shower, in bridge space led overboard and fitted with efficient brass non-return valves. ✓
