I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for DAMAGE stated to have been caused by contact with Motor Barge "JOHN M RUSHWORTH" towing Barge "S.F. FLORENCE" in River Trent 20/10/64.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

FOUND (Damage situated on port side in way of forecastle 'tween decks and fore peak tank).

Shell. (Nos. from fwd).

No.1 plate in forecastle sheerstrake heavily set in on bottom edge and torn in several places (maximum set in approx. 9" over a length of 10 feet).

Nos.1 & 2 plates on main sheerstrake set in and torn in several places. No.1 plate in 1st strake below main sheer slightly set in on upper edge. Upper deck plating in way of fore peak tank badly buckled adjacent to shell, a length of about 9 feet and torn in several places. Several "beam knee" struts in fore peak tank buckled.

The Owners Superintendent requested that owing to the vessels commitments only temporary repairs be effected at this time and this in my opinion merits favourable consideration. Contd...

I recommend that this ship remain as classed ~~xxx~~/without fresh record of dry docking subject to set in and torn shell plating (p.s.) in way of forecastle and fore peak tank and structure in way (temporarily repaired) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking and to any other conditions at present attached to the vessels class being dealt with as previously recommended.

(Where conditions of class are recommended to be retained, imposed, amended or deleted, particulars must be stated above and on the interim certificate.)

TEMPORARY REPAIRS NOW DONE:-

Welded doubling plates fitted on shell in way of damaged plating.
Flanged plate welded to deck and shell fitted in fore-castle
over damaged deck plating to make the fore peak tank watertight.
3 new O.A. struts fitted in way of badly buckled beam knees.

Repairs examined on completion and found satisfactory.

It is submitted that this item be noted in the S.R.L. to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking, being considered to remain efficient meantime.
