examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the*

I have to report that I found FOREMAST (steel) *in good condition.*

*No mast wedges. Shrouds, stays and eyeplates in good order. All rigging
screws and shackles to anneal and overhaul. Heart in fore-stay broken,
to renew.*

*MAINMAST (steel) in good condition. No mast wedges. Wood topmast &
lightning conductor on same, in good order. Shrouds, stays and
eyeplates in good order. All rigging screws and shackles to anneal
and overhaul.*

No funnel stays fitted.
