A report has been received from the Society's Hull Surveyors of the survey held between December, 1958, and February, 1959, from which it is noted that the ship has been examined in dry dock and a new main engine fitted.

The screwshaft was specially examined at this time and the Surveyors report that no further extension of the lamination was observed, but recommend that the screwshaft at the forward end of the keyway be again examined before the end of June, 1960. The class of the ship has accordingly been continued subject to this matter receiving attention by that time.

A fresh record of Docking Survey 1.59 has been assigned.
