Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that just prior to the fusion of Lloyd's Register and the British Corporation, the latter received a request from Messrs. D.J. Papadimitriou Sons of Alexandria for a classification survey to be held on the steamer "TOKAR".

I enclose herewith a copy of this request together with a copy of the reply sent by the British Corporation, and will let you know if the Managers decide to take the matter any farther.

It is observed from the Register Book that the vessel was built under the Society's survey so that any classification now to be granted should be that of Lloyd's Register and not of the British Corporation.

For this purpose a Drilling Survey would of course be necessary which is almost precisely similar in character to the Special Survey Type 4 quoted by the British Corporation.

Meantime of course you should take no action until you are approached but please keep me advised of any developments.
