Dear Sirs,

S.S. "TOKAR"

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 14 making application for this ship to be surveyed for classification purposes. On March 25 The British Corporation Register became united with Lloyd's Register, so this case will be dealt with by the United Societies.

For consideration for classification it will be necessary to have carried out the hull and machinery the full requirements of special survey type 4 including docking, drillings, boilers, main steam pipes, tailshaft and annual load line surveys. In addition all repairs and renewals as found necessary, should be completed in conjunction with the surveys.

Instructions to this effect will be sent to the surveyors at Alexandria where it is assumed the owners will have the classification surveys effected. Should this to be the case I would be obliged if you inform me so soon as possible as to when and at which port the owners desire to have the surveys carried out.
