Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the Vessels named in your Reports of Survey, numbered below, have been classed as against the same expressed.

"TERRA NOVA". I shall be glad to receive a reply to the enquiry contained in my Classing Letter of the 11th August last.

6587 "IMPERIAL WINNIPEG". As recommended, except that a record of Blr.S 7,53 has been assigned.

It is concluded that only the testing of the tanks, etc., enumerated under the heading of "Progressive Hull Survey" can be credited towards this inspection, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this.

It is noted from your report that the boiler safety valves were adjusted to a pressure of 475 lb. per square inch, and it is concluded that they were not so adjusted on account of the condition of the boilers or machinery, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this.
